This time it's about the life of Marjan Amalietti, the Slovenian artist whose fabulous work I have in possession and intend to start exhibiting in Holland and Paris. All in all, it looks like I won't be bored for a minute and...with a bit of luck I may land myself a new job as a columnist,

having stopped writing my Call me Madam column for Penthouse after 35 years. It was fun writing for them but now it's time to move on to new groundsand explore a new readership. And.. if any of you decides to see the latest film about the life and times of Linda Lovelace
